## FACILITY Solutions

Facility Solutions continues our dedication to serving the unique needs of churches, camps, and various ministries. With a deep understanding of the spiritual and community-centric aspects of these organizations, we offer bespoke architectural solutions that meet their specific ministry needs.

In recent weeks, we have completed construction documents for a church in Hutto, Texas. While construction documents are an important part of how we serve the Body of Christ, we also firmly believe that the prayerful planning process leading up to construction is just as important as the construction itself. To that end, we have recently completed two church master plans, one in Longview, Texas, and the other in Jacksonville, Texas. In both cases, the churches were looking to provide additional fellowship space for their congregations to gather as a body and to help facilitate ministry within the community.

In the past couple months, we have also had an influx of redesign requests from ministries we had provided construction documents for around the start of and during the pandemic. Many of them are resuming construction and have requested modifications to the plans to meet their current budget needs. We recognize that the construction industry is in upheaval with many costs skyrocketing. What was an affordable solution two,

three, or even four years ago when the documents were issued has evolved into a financial burden. Engaging in the updating process ensures that the facilities we design can

adapt and grow alongside the communities they support. We are honored to be a part of their journey, ensuring that with these updates the facilities can complete construction and be a beacon of hope and community for years to come.

Over the past year, we participated in 20 events, primarily aimed at seeking new clients for our projects and engaging in recruitment activities. These events facilitated hundreds of face-to-face interactions. This year, I initiated a new practice of sending emails whenever we obtain a list

of attendees from other ministries. While I make a diligent effort to ensure that every person present receives one of our brochures, I believe that sending follow-up emails could also aid in generating new projects.

This year a new opportunity for Vehicle Solutions as we embarked on a special project for LeTourneau University. We provided them with five minivans to facilitate 10-day mission trips for their students. During these trips, a total of 7,031 miles were covered. Additionally, we were blessed to purchase another



van. The previous purchase, less than a year ago, has already accumulated over 26,000 miles, and we anticipate that this new addition will see similar usage.

a vital resource, offering students access to six comprehensive courses along with invaluable ministry opportunities and mentorship. Our recent rewrite of the website represents a significant enhancement, empowering mentors and administrative staff with advanced functionalities. Now, they can effortlessly track student progress, generate reports and statistics, and seamlessly update course information as needed. This upgrade promises to streamline operations and enhance the overall user experience for both students and administrators.

Another project that has recently kicked off is for Christians Sharing Christ Film Ministries (CSCFM). CSCFM utilizes Jesus

film-type movies to effectively plant churches through indigenous workers. While they have had a website in place for reporting key metrics such as film showings, attendance numbers, salvations, and churches planted each month, extracting and summarizing this data was a labor-intensive process. However, with our new website solution, we aim to simplify this process significantly. We're currently in the testing phase, and soon CSCFM workers will be able to generate reports and access statistics with just the click of a button, saving them hours of manual effort.

Progress continues on our mobile applications, StoryPublisher Advanced (SPadv) and HoneyBee, thanks primarily to our dedicated team of volunteers. SPadv, designed for orally translating Bible stories, has been available for some time and continues to evolve. Meanwhile, HoneyBee, aimed at translating Bible text, is currently in the development and testing phase. Both apps share a common mission: to accelerate the dissemination of scripture in unwritten languages and languages without access to the Bible. It's worth noting that we've been undertaking this project pro bono, driven solely by our passion for advancing the Gospel. Your support towards the development of SPadv would enable us to further invest in these transformative initiatives.


